AFFIDAVIT OF JUSTINE SCRAMSTEAD


I, JUSTINE SCRAMSTEAD, of THE City of Selkirk, in the Province of
Manitoba,

MAKE OATH AND SAY THAT:


1. I have personal knowledge of the facts and matters deposed to by me, except where same is expressed to be on the basis of information and belief, in which case I believe them to be true.
2. I am a Tribal Member of Peguis First Nation (the "**First Nation**").

3. I was appointed to act as a scrutineer in the 2023 General Election for a candidate for the applicant, Glenn Hudson. My role was to attend on the day of the general election to observe and supervise the vote.
4. I attended the General Election vote on April 6, 2023, in Selkirk at 240 Main Street. I was there from polls opening at 10:00 am until approximately two hours before polls closing, when I was relieved by a man and woman scrutineers. Once I was there I had a conversation with Shari Bear, who I know, and who was there as a scrutineer for Martin Favel. Shari had a list of eligible voters that she received from Mr. Favel. I did not receive a list, and so relied on this list in my role as scrutineer.
5. I observed several individuals present themselves to electoral officers in order to vote, only to be told their names were not on the eligible voter's list they were provided.
6. I cross-referenced several of these names and found that in several instances the voter's name was on my list as an eligible voter, but not on the electoral officer's list. I observed several individuals who were listed as eligible voters on my list leave the polling station without voting.
7. I approached an electoral officer and highlighted the discrepancy between the lists, and she said "this is what we were given to use for the election" or words that effect. I did not advance the matter any further.
8. It is my opinion that there were discrepancies between the eligible voter's list provided by Martin Favel, and the list that the electoral officers were relying on to conduct the election. I witnessed several band members leave the polling station without voting after being told they were not on the eligible voter list.
9. I make this affidavit bona fide and for no improper purpose.
